You are requested to forward the application form of the eligible faculty member, as per the prescribed format to the Post Graduate School, by **December 04, 2021** and no application shall be entertained after the last date.

GUIDELINES FOR THE BEST TEACHER AWARD SPONSERED BY THE ICAR FOR AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITIES

Higher Agricultural Education Institutions (HAEIs) have witnessed notable expansion in the recent past. Human resources have played a pivotal role in bringing excellence in HAEIs besides development and dissemination of new technologies. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research has a provision to sponsor Best Teacher Awards in HAEIs in the country to promote such excellence. For the sake of uniformity across the HAEIs, guidelines for awarding teachers for their academic excellence have been prepared.

The details of this award are given below:

- 1. The scheme is extended to all the CAUs, CUs with Agriculture Faculty, SAUs and Deemed- to- be Universities (Altogether called as Higher Agricultural Education Institutions, HAEIs) under National Agricultural Education and Research System
- 2. Title of this award will be "Best Teacher Award in Agricultural Higher Education.....(year)."
- 3. The award will carry a cash prize of Rs. 50,000/- with a citation and a plaque.
- 4. It will be an annual event give at the Annual Convocation or in a function on the Teachers Day/Foundation Day every year.
- 5. The number of the awards in a particular HAEI will be **ONE**
- 6. The award in each HAEI will be coordinated by Dean (Resident Instruction) / Dean (PG Studies). Heads/Deans should not apply for the award. The application form will be invited by the Coordinator, which will be submitted through HoD to the Dean. The Dean of the Colleges after having nomination from each Department, will forward one name to the Coordinator*. The Coordinator will receive the nomination from all Deans. Thereafter, all nominations will be put up to the Judgment Committee for its final recommendation. The Vice Chancellor will approve one name recommended by the Judgment Committee.
- 7. The applicant must have at least 5 years of teaching/research/ extension experience as regular faculty member in a HAEI.
- 8. The applications/proposals will be invited by the Coordinator every year.
- 9. The application/proposals in prescribed format will be enrouted through proper channel. It will be signed by the candidate and endorsed by at least three of his/her passedout postgraduate students (as major advisor) and two peers from the HAEI.
- 10. The candidate must have at least three 'outstanding', but not less than two 'very good' annual appraisal/self appraisal reports out of immediate past five reports.
- 11. The candidate is expected to be a role model teacher with high moral values and must not have been penalized or any enquiry pending against him/her.

- 12. The candidature will remain valid for three years with entitlement to the candidate to update his/her biodata every year.
- 13. The judgment committee will be as follows:

a. An external expert (not below the rank of Vice Chancellor)	= One
b. Deans/Directors from other agricultural Universities nominated	
by the Vice Chancellor)	= Two
c. DDG (Agricultural Education), ICAR, New Delhi or his nominee	= One
d. Coordinator	= One

14. Decision of thejudgment committee (after approval of the Vice Chancellor) will be final. There will be no appeal againstit.

^{*} Dean (or the university) can develop own procedure for it. For example, a candidate who has maximum number of 'Outstanding' rating of the Annual Assessment Reports out of the last five years
